Day 1: Departure Day - Flight to Paris

Upon arrival, we begin our Parisian stroll at the square of Notre-Dame Cathedral, walking along the Seine into the historic Latin Quarter. Enjoy charming cafés, bookshops, and a laid-back welco-

Day 3: Paris Icons & Versailles Palace

Begin the day with a guided city tour of Paris, covering the Arc de Triomphe, Champs-Élysées, Place de la Concorde, and more. In the afternoon, travel to the Palace of Versailles, where you'll explore the opulent halls and magnificent gardens of Louis XIV's palace. Return to Paris for free time in Montmartre, the artistic hilltop neighborhood known for the

Day 4: Art, Iron & Riverlight - Louvre, Eiffel Tower & Seine Cruise

Start the day at the Louvre Museum, home to the Mona Lisa and treasures of Western civilization. Later, enjoy dinner and visit the Eiffel Tower (photo stop or optional climb*). As the sun sets, board a Seine River Cruise, gliding past illuminated landmarks like Notre-Dame and the Eiffel Tower. Return to Paris for free time in Montmartre, the artistic hilltop neighborhood known for the Sacré-Cœur and its sweeping views and dinner.

Day 5: Into Provence - Avignon & Pont du Gard

Travel by high-speed TGV train to Avignon, the historic papal city in the heart of Provence. Enjoy lunch in the old town before visiting the Papal Palace and the Pont d'Avignon. In the afternoon, visit the stunning Pont du Gard, a Roman aqueduct and engineering marvel, followed by a scenic picnic dinner.

Day 6: Lavender & Villages - Gordes, Lavender Fields & Arles

A full-day journey through the Provençal countryside:
-Stroll the stone streets of Gordes, one of France's most picturesque villages
-Visit lavender fields in full bloom (seasonal: June-July) or enjoy panoramic countryside views year-round
-Explore Arles, a Roman-era town once painted by Van Gogh and enjoy dinner in the hearth of the city

Day 7: Cross into Spain - Girona & Barcelona Arrival

Say au revoir to France as we head south. Stop for lunch in Girona, Spain - a medieval gem with colorful riverfront houses and cobbled lanes. In the evening, arrive in Barcelona, settle in, and enjoy a welcome tapas dinner by the beach or in

Day 8: Barcelona Wonders - Gaudí, Free Time & Jazz Cruise

Morning tour highlights the surreal genius of Antoni Gaudí:
-Visit the whimsical Park Güell
-Explore the breathtaking Sagrada Família
Enjoy a free afternoon to shop, visit the Picasso Museum*, or unwind at the beach. In the evening, set sail on a Sunset Jazz Cruise, enjoying the Mediterranean breeze and skyline followed by a traditional Paella dinner.

Day 9: High-Speed to Madrid - Markets & Royalty

Travel by AVE train to Madrid in under 3 hours. After arriving, enjoy lunch at the buzzing San Miguel Market, sampling regional bites. Later, take a guided tour of Madrid, including the elegant Royal Palace and the bustling Puerta del Sol. In the evening, enjoy your first dinner in Madrid.

Day 10: Madrid Masterpieces & Flamenco Finale
